




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Lower the tailgate and remove the 2 bolts on the driver and passenger sides using an 8mm socket/wrench. **See Photo 1**.
- 2. Pull the brake light off. See Photo 2 and Photo 3.






3. Unplug the brake light. See Photo 4.





4. Press the tabs for the side trim panels using a long flatheaded screwdriver. See Photo 5 and Photo 6.










5. Work your way across the side of the bed removing the trim. See Photo 7 and Photo 8.





- 6. Lay out the bed rack components. See Photo 9.
- 7. Install the 8mm hammer nuts in the 10" bars and secure the bed rack mounts to each of the 10" bars with the 8mm button head bolts and lock washers using a 5mm Allen wrench. **See Photo 10**, **Photo 11**, and **Photo 12**.














- 8. Install the end caps on the corner pieces. See Photo 13.
- 9. Install the 41-1/4" side bar to the bed rack mounts using the 8mm bolts, lock washers, and hammer nuts. **See Photo 14**.





- 10. Install the 38" cross bars using the 8mm bolts and hammer nuts. See Photo 15.
- 11. Place the rack on the bed. See Photo 16.





- 12. Mark the holes with a paint pen and make sure there is sufficient room to drill without intersecting another hole.

 NOTE: You may need to adjust the location forward/backward to keep from drilling through an existing hole.

 See Photo 17.
- 13. Drill the marked holes using a 17/32" drill bit. See Photo 18.








- 14. Using a nutsert tool (recommended): Install the supplied 5/16" nutserts using a nutsert tool. See Photo 19.
- 15. **Using wrenches instead of a nutsert tool:** Using the supplied 5/16" x 1-1/4" bolt, washer, and the 3/8" nut screw them into a nut insert. **See Photo 20**. Next place the assembly into the drilled hole. Next using a 1/2" wrench and a 9/16" wrench tighten the bolt while holding the nut with the 9/16" wrench. This will compress the nut insert and lock it into place in the drilled hole.





- 16. Repeat the process for the remainder of the nutserts.
- 17. Reinstall the trim to the sides of the bed and reinstall the brake lights.
- 18. Cut out the templates at the end of this instructions manual and drill through the trim so the bolts can be installed to the nutserts. **See Photo 21** and **Photo 22**.

A NOTICE Drill cautiously through the trim so you do not drill through the nutserts.





- 19. Flip the template over for the other side of the vehicle and repeat the process.
- 20. Install all the supplied 5/16" button head bolts to secure the bed rack using a 3/16" Allen wrench. See Photo 23.



- 21. Press in the plastic T-slot covers in the slots in the rails to minimize dust getting in--these will need to be trimmed.
- 22. Insert the plastic 11/32" plugs into the remaining holes to minimize dust getting in.

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
